Common drug plans include: Humana, Bravo, AARP, Community Care Rx Basic, WellCare, and SilverScript

Your current drug plan might change in January 2010.

- ⇒ **You might be switched out of your current plan if you don't choose another one.**
- ⇒ **Your current drug plan might not pay for all of your drugs next year.**

You might be able to lower your Medicare prescription drug costs.
