# I didn't get my stimulus money! What can I do?

## It depends on which payments are missing

There were three rounds of payments: **First round**: Up to \$1,200 per adult + \$500 for each child **Second round**: Up to \$600 per adult + \$600 for each child **Third round**: Up to \$1,400 per adult + \$1,400 for each dependent (child or adult)

The first two rounds were for **2020**. The third round was for **2021**. The IRS calls the stimulus payments "*Recovery Rebate Credits*" because they were actually advances of tax credits.

- If you are missing a payment from the first two rounds, you can file a **2020** tax return and claim the Recovery Rebate Credit on Line 30 of IRS Form 1040.
- If you are missing a payment from the third round, you can file a **2021** tax return and claim the Recovery Rebate Credit on Line 30 of IRS Form 1040.
- If you are missing a payment from the first two rounds *and* a payment from the third round, you will have to file both a 2020 and a 2021 return.
- To claim the credit, you will need to know how much money you are missing. For more information, go to <u>EIP Payments</u>
