



Reapportion Suit Faces Va. Resort

NORFOLK, Va., Dec. 29 AP) - Four Virginia Beach citizens turned to the U.S. District Court today to force redistricting of the City's boroughs on a population

The suit is similar to one denied by the Virginia Supreme Court Nov. 30.

Today's suit was filed by Norfolk Del. Henry E. Howell Jr., representing J. E. Clayton Davis, Rolland B. Winter, Cornelius D. Scully and Howard W. Martin.

The plaintiffs ask relief under the equal protection clause of the 14th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, the route followed in Virginia and other states in litigation that resulted in Federal Court orders to redistrict state legislatures.

They cited disparities in councilmanic representation

The plaintiffs noted that the Blackwater borough has one councilman for 733 pophe ulation while Bayside has one for 29,048.

"By reason of the gross and aggravating disparity, the voice and vote of the resident of Blackwater is 40 times more influential than the voice and vote of a resident of Bayside Borough," the plaintiffs contended.
